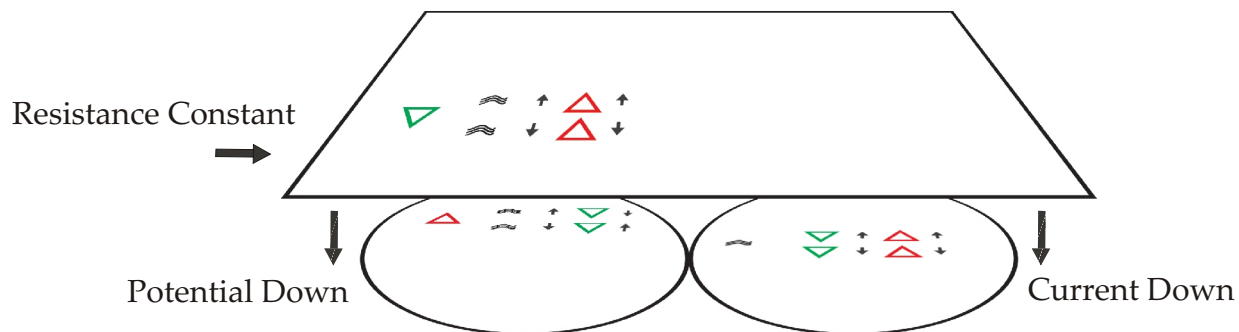

The Story.

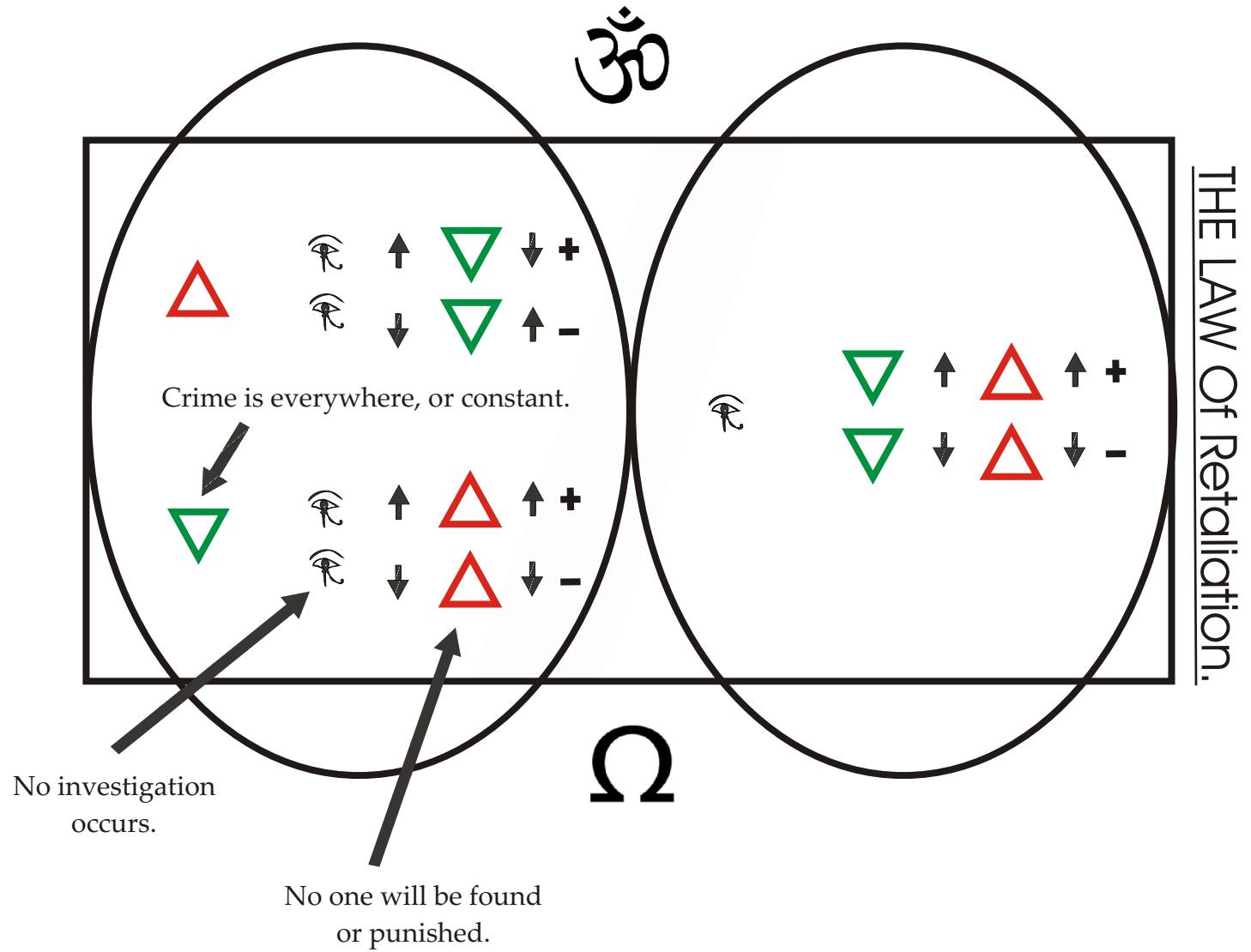
Eventually a crime of desire leads to a rally cry.

society is spiraling downward into anarchy.

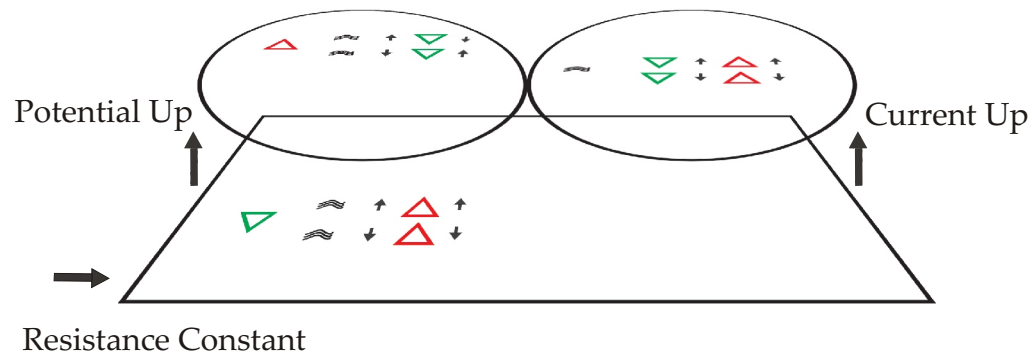

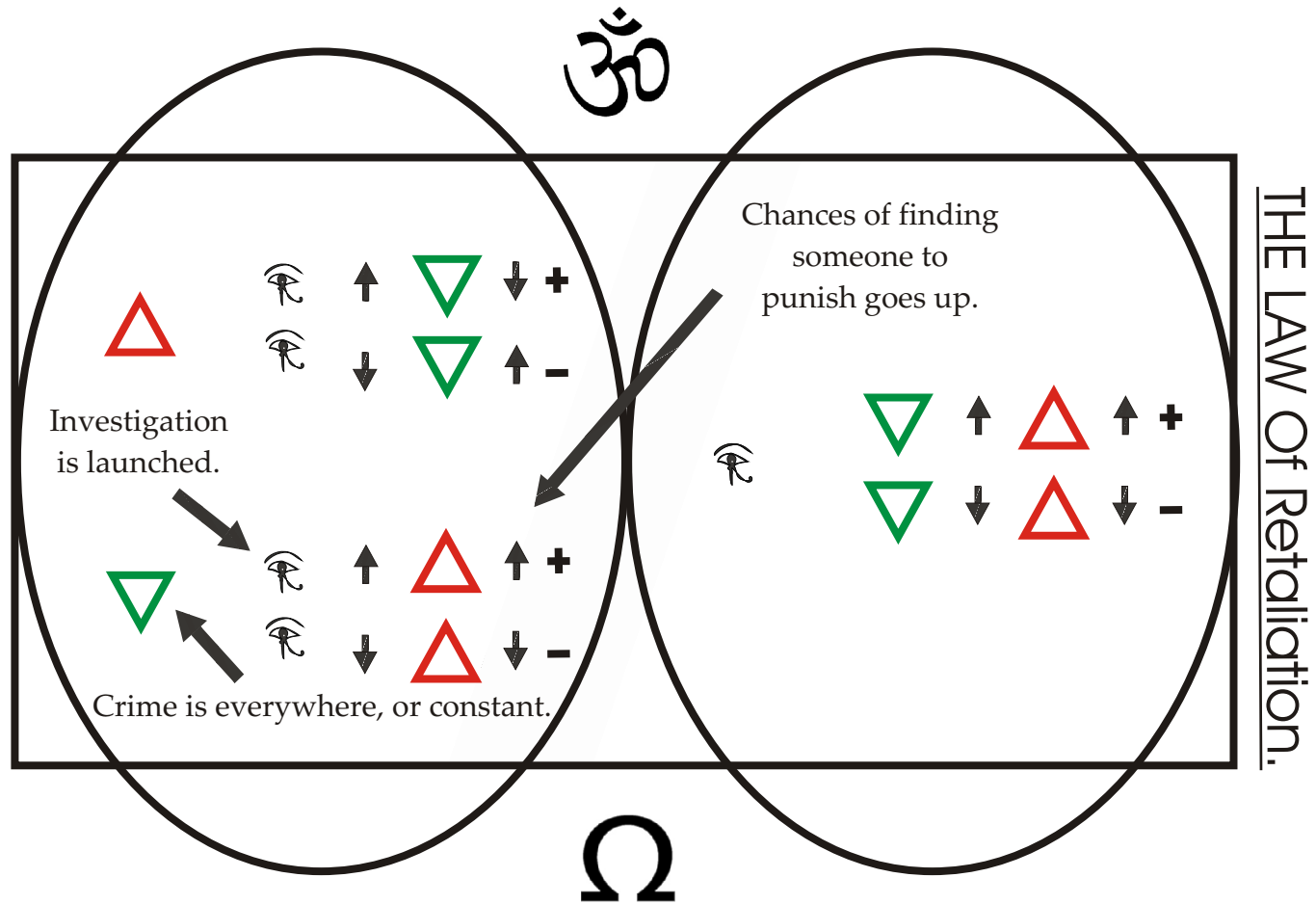


The Story.

When a crime occurs if you want justice, or punishment, an investigation must be launched.

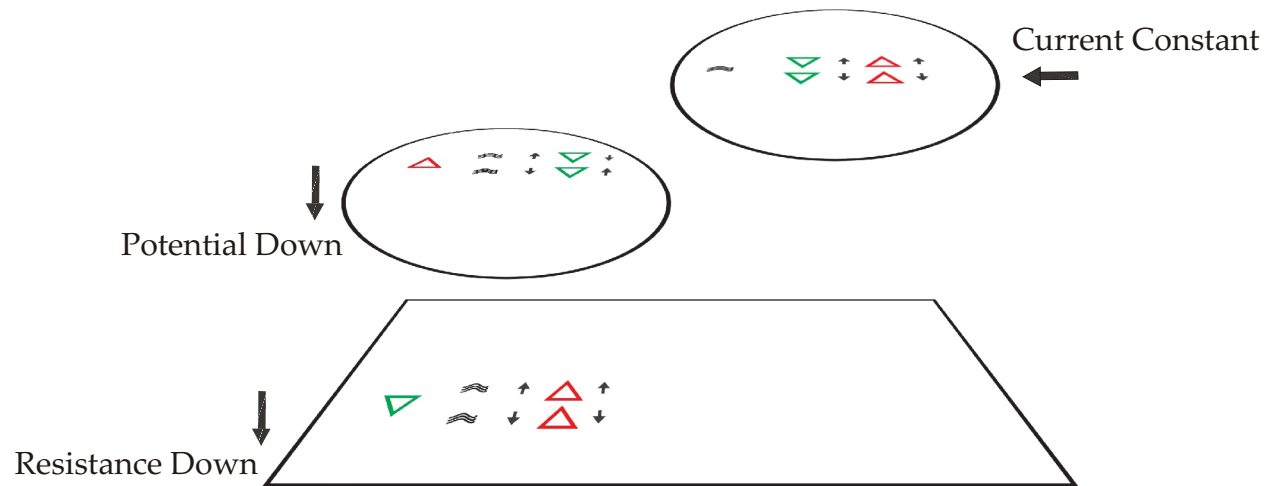

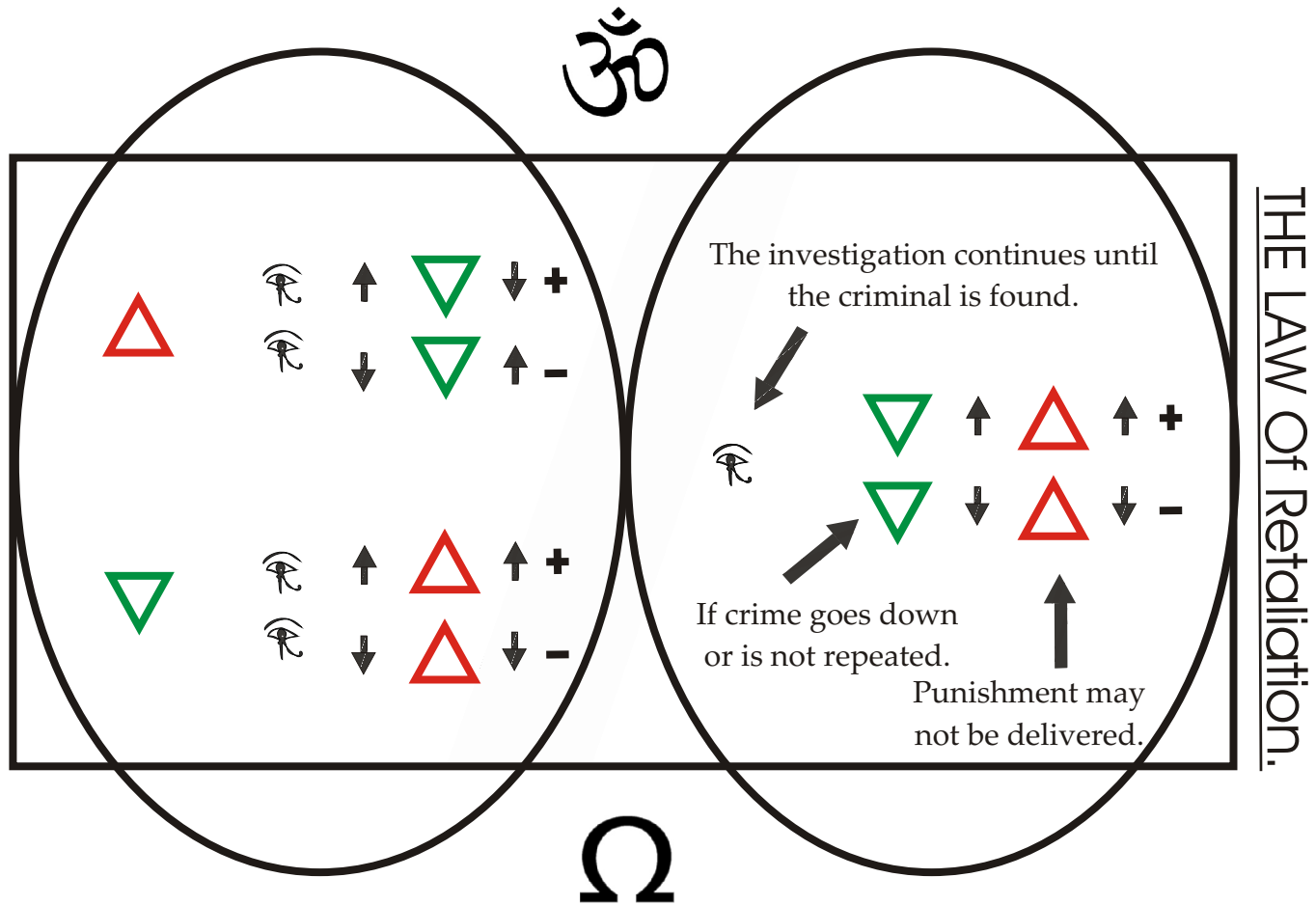


The Story.

they may never be found or get punished.

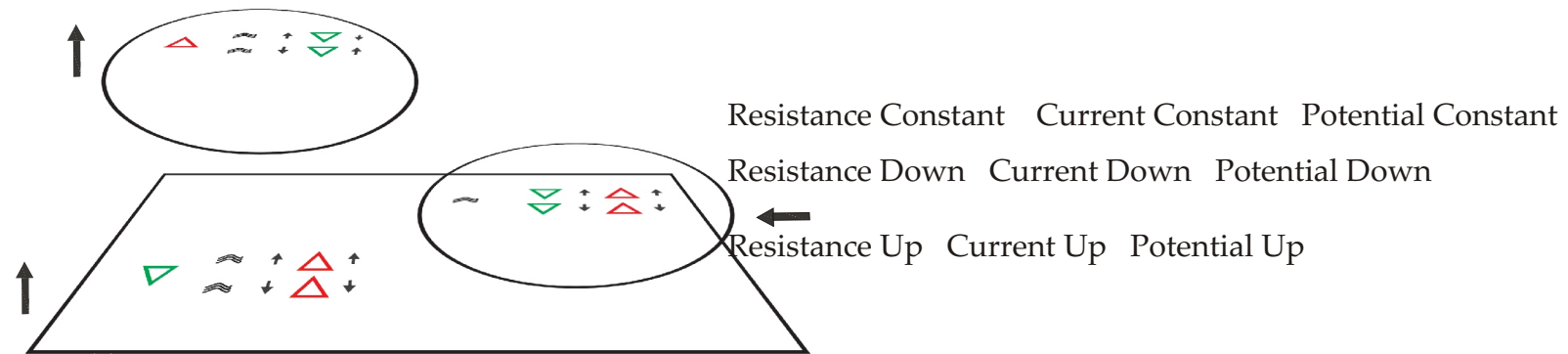

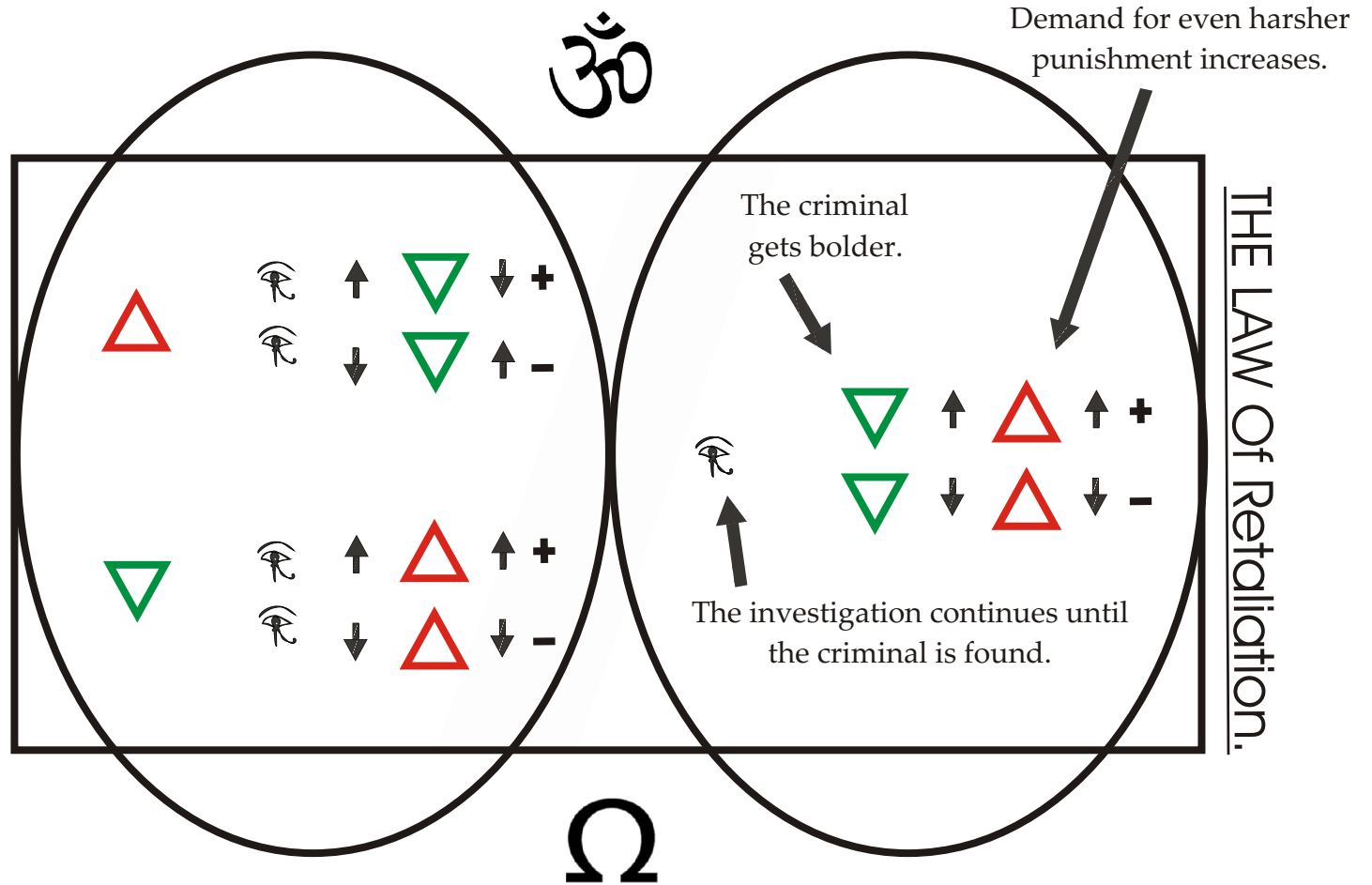


The Story.

in proportion to the crime wave.

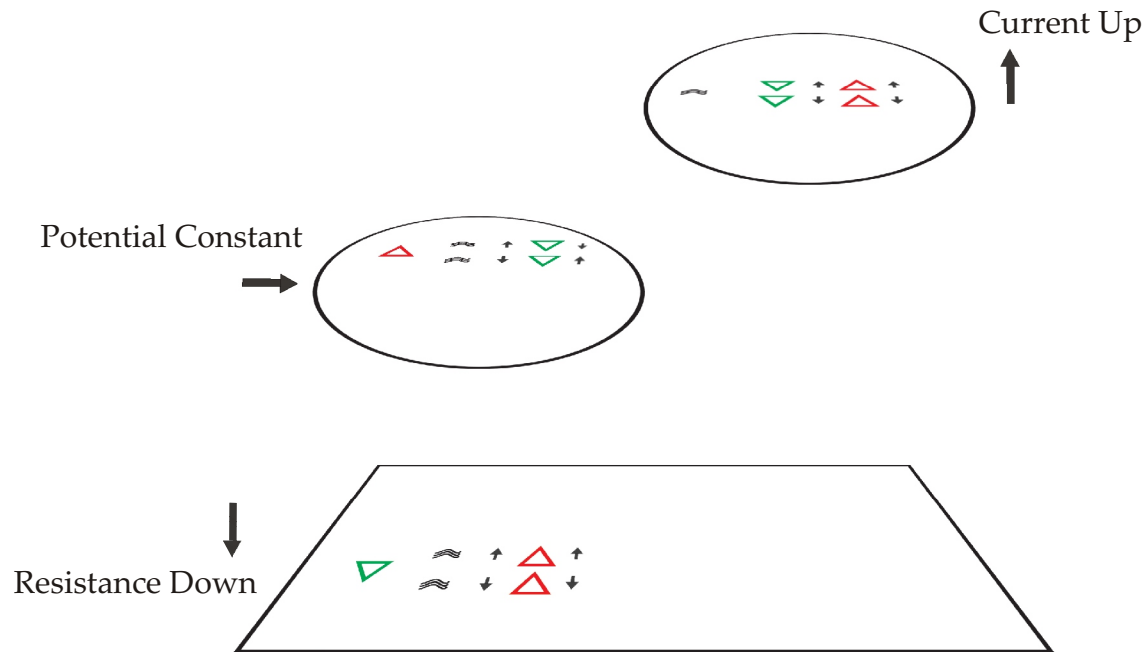

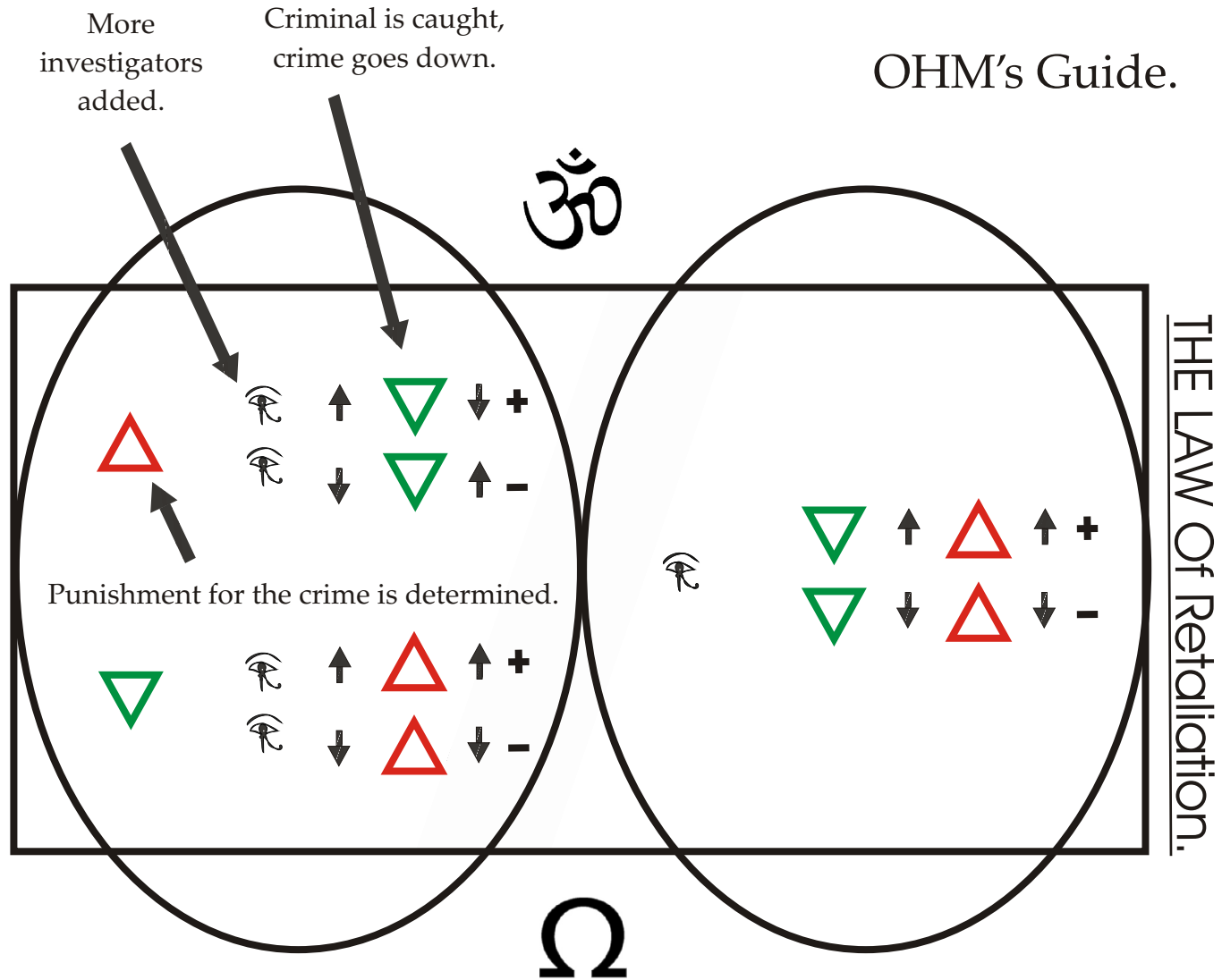


The Story.

causing individual crimes to stop.

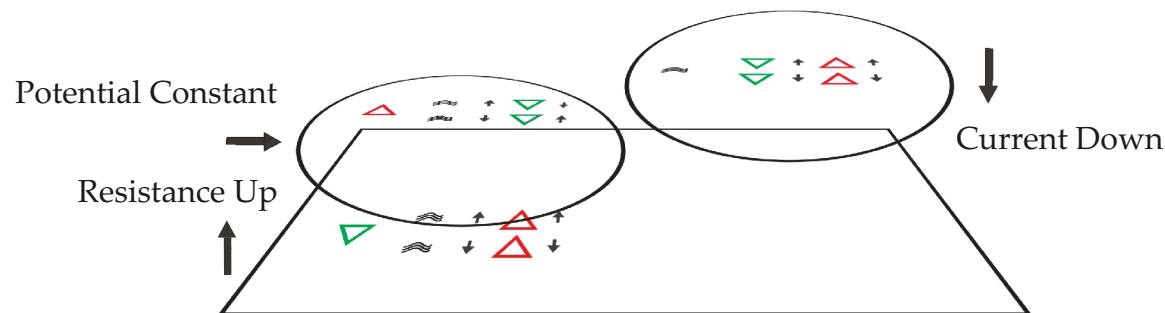

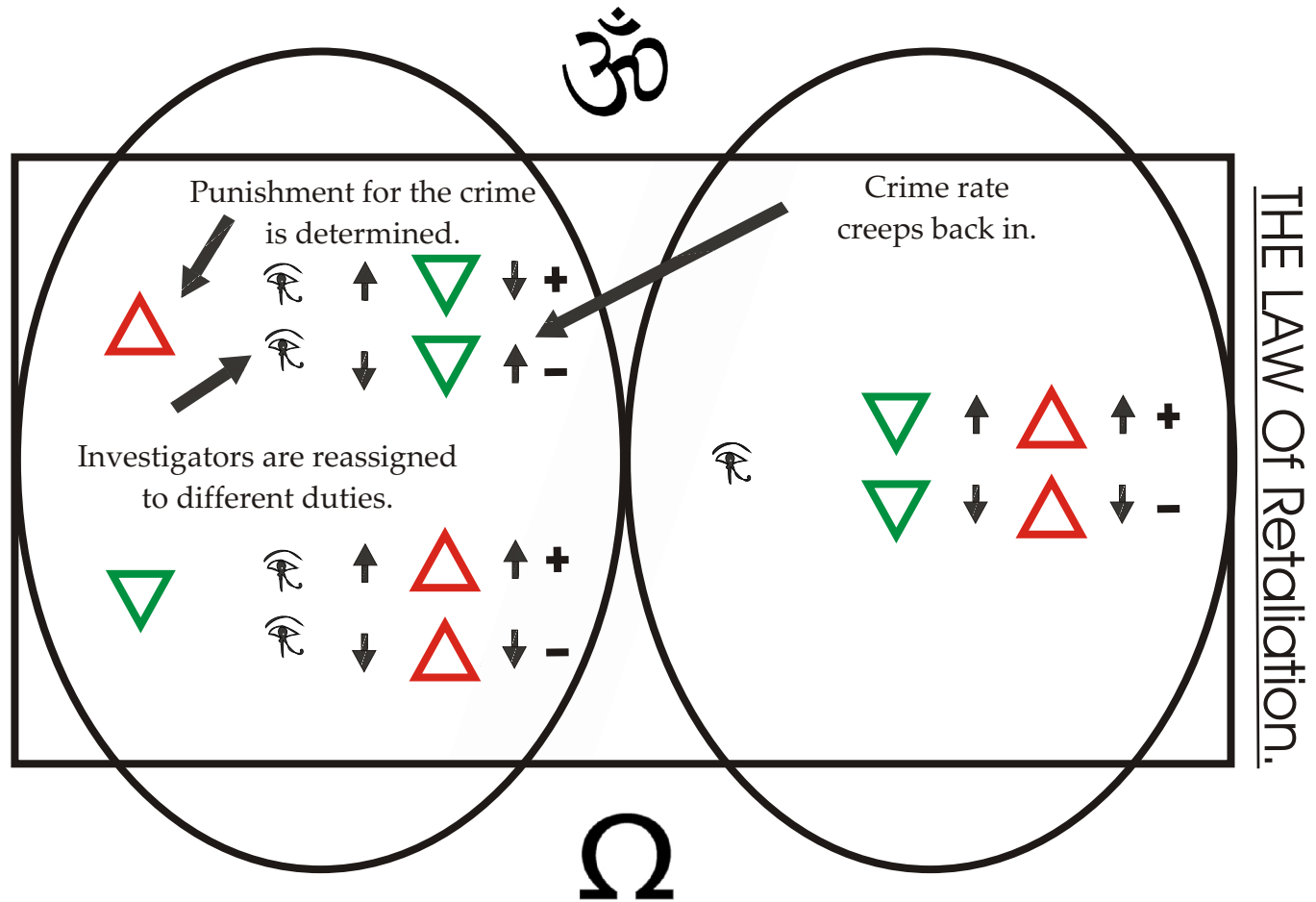


The Story.
