

# CHAPTER FIVE Ohm's Law Of Survival.





Others seeking established comforts prey.

...by strengthening the group.


If competition is established or constant and you cannot compete or work with others you have no time to innovate because you are always fleeing.






You can't compete as in individual or cooperate with others to compete as a group.


If competition is the order of the day those who cannot compete, but can work together, will be forced to create innovative tools for survival.






If a single innovation is enough to resolve the competitive state a slide back to meeting the unconscious needs of basic survival splits up the cooperative group.


Everyone goes back to looking out for themself.






Once the wave of innovation is established, the harder the competitors push the more people are forced to work together.


This builds until cooperative alliances are forced even amongst the competitors.







Once the cooperative group is established, or committed to staying together, as they become more innovative the barbarians are warded off.


Next, being more aware, they realize together, they can overcome other resistances.
